↔ Vineyard Notes ↔

2014 marks the third vintage in a row (count 'em!) that Mother Nature has seen fit to grace California with another banner harvest. Once again we got off to a warm, early start to Spring and enjoyed a fairly mild summer with a handful of heat spikes between late May and early August. Normal yields across the board led to a mid-August harvest and some perfectly ripe grapes.

↔ Tasting Notes ↔

The Manifesto Cabernet Sauvignon is beautifully dark brick red in color, with rich notes of black pepper and dark fruits on the nose. As this wine breathes, subtle notes of cassis and black olive come forward. The black pepper and dark fruit flavors continue to the palate, where they are joined with hints of oak and vanilla.
