2015 marks the fourth consecutive year of the California drought, and the vines are beginning to feel the effects. The harvest this year provided a smaller yield than previous seasons, but here's the good news- smaller yields create amazing, small batch wines. Smaller grapes are absolutely packed with flavor and color, and create some stellar wines. We had a beautiful, warm summer with very little rain, which allowed our grapes to ripen perfectly in the Valley sunshine.

↔ Tasting Notes ↔

Pale straw in color, this wine opens with notes of honey and wildflowers, reminding us of a beautiful, warm summer afternoon. Secondary notes of green apple add a nice snap of acidity to the silky honey. The palate is round and bright with delicious flavors of apple, apricot, and Meyer lemon.
